Looking at the original Hebrew & Greek words!

Looking up the meanings of Bible words in the original Hebrew or Greek language can be very eye-opening. The KJV Bible has been exhaustively referenced by Strong's Concordance so that every significant word can be examined. Strong's has assigned a number to each word in alphabetical order. For example, in Genesis 1:1, "In the beginning" – the word 'beginning' is assigned the number H7225 (H= Hebrew for the O.T.) Using a free Bible program, we can discover in seconds that the Hebrew word is 'reshiyth', and means, "the first, in place, time, order or rank (specifically a firstfruit)" – and is used throughout the KJV as 'beginning, chief (-est), first (fruits) part, time, principle, thing.'

It is very easy to download the FREE <u>My Sword Bible</u> App for Android, and <u>E-Sword</u> for Apple. This gives you the ability to study the Bible on your phone or computer, compare different translations, look up Strong's Hebrew and Greek Lexicon, read popular commentaries and even write your own insights and study notes directly on your smartphone or tablet. It's very easy to use.
